PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

To recognize and honor the small railroad employee who has demonstrated the most outstanding safety achievement, with special emphasis on initiatives that improve employee safety in the workplace.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All employees of ASLRRA member railroads are candidates to receive this prestigious award. All railroad members are encouraged to nominate the individual who best exemplifies a model of safe work performance.

WHEN WILL THE AWARD BE PRESENTED?

The 2006 winner will be recognized at ASLRRA's Annual Convention in Orlando, Florida on April 24, 2006. The winner and one additional individual will be the guests of the ASLRRA at the convention, including travel and accommodation expenses.

HOW DO YOU NOMINATE AN EMPLOYEE?

- Nominations shall be submitted, in typewritten or electronic Word document format, not to exceed two pages in length over the signature of the railroad's CEO.
- Nominations shall be submitted **NO LATER** than **Friday, March 24, 2006**
- Nominations shall be restricted to one candidate per ASLRRA member railroad.

- Nominations will then be forwarded to the Selection Committee for final decision.



NOMINATION CRITERIA CONSIDERS THE FOLLOWING FACTORS:

- Nominee must not have sustained an FRA-reportable injury.
- Nominee must exhibit a high degree of safety awareness through visible promotion of safety programs and initiatives, as well as leadership by example. *Provide examples in the nomination.*
- Nominee must contribute off-duty time to activities promoting community safety and involvement in social service. *Provide examples in the nomination.*
- Please indicate any other traits or characteristics that exemplify a nominee worthy of winning the ASLRRA Safety Person of the Year Award.

Please note that all criteria must be met. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

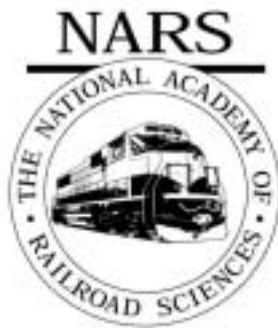
