- Use hashtags: #RailDay2025 (official), #RailChampions, #FreightRail
- Mention your hometown Make your voice personal and local.
- Stay positive and professional Thank them for meeting.
- Engage others Share and like posts across platforms from @GoRail, @ASLRRA, @AAR_FreightRail.

© Key Messages

- Freight Rail Fuels America's Economy: Every \$1 invested in rail transportation drives \$2.50 in economic activity. Every railroad job creates 3.9 additional jobs in industries like manufacturing, logistics and technology.
- Freight Rail Powers Top-Tier Careers: With 153,000 employees, rail jobs pay 40% above the national average and rank among the safest industries to work in the nation.
- Balanced Policies Drive Rail Investment: Smart regulations enable freight railroads to invest \$23 billion annually in infrastructure, service, and sustainability—reducing emissions, easing congestion, and lessening taxpayer burden.
- Grant Programs Result in Safer and More Efficient Communities. Federal grant
 programs like Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvements (CRISI),
 Railroad Crossing Elimination (RCE), and Section 130 are essential to keeping railroads
 and the communities they serve safe.
