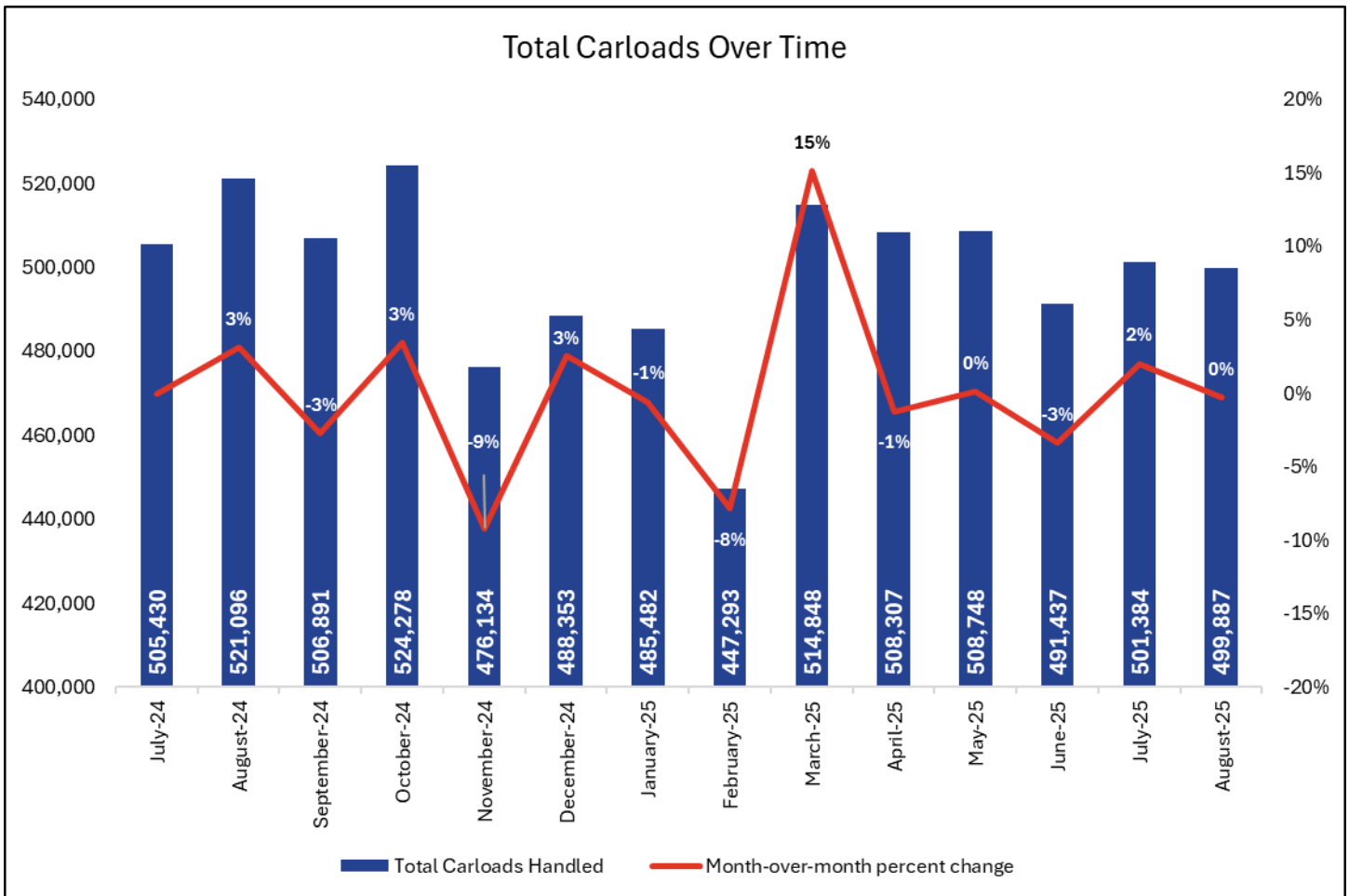
ASLRRRA Launches New Short Line Carloads Report

ASLRRRA is excited to share a new offering for its members – a monthly carload index. While Railinc and Railway Age used to produce a similar report, they recently stopped production.

Using data sourced from Railinc, ASLRRRA’s new Short Line Carload Report will include all three of the ways that a carload can travel in the U.S. on a short line: originated, bridged, and terminated. ASLRRRA has also included the new category of ‘total carloads handled’ which is each carload handled by a U.S. short line at least once, whether that occurs as an origination, bridge, or termination event.

Overall Short Line Carloads Volumes

Over the past year you can see the overall carload trends and their month-over-month percent change. This data series begins with July 2024 carloads, hence there is no data for a month to month change in that field.

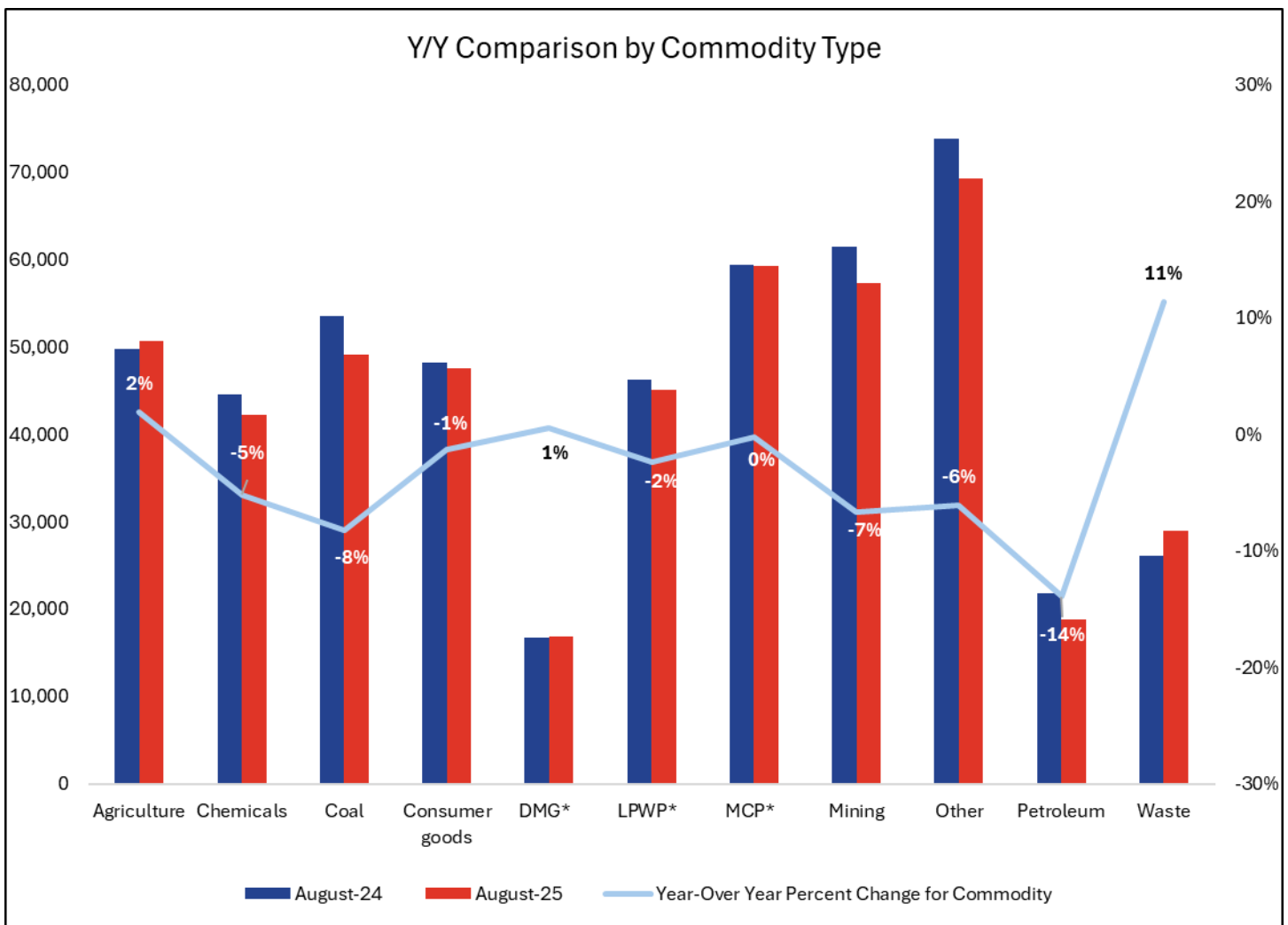


Short Line Carload Trends

Comparing overall carloads handled, as well as by movement-type, shows August 2025 figures contracting across the board compared to August 2024 volumes. Bridged movements suffered the greatest contraction while both originations and terminations were only modestly down. Total carload trips that were touched by a short line decreased by 3%.

The following chart provides the Year-Over-Year monthly comparison by commodity, identifying the drivers of overall carload volume.

 LPWP – Lumber, Paper and Wood Products

For August, short line carloads movements were led by Waste (11%), Agriculture (2%), and Durable Manufactured Goods (1%) as the only commodity categories with growth compared to August 2024. Petroleum products led the yearly comparative contractions at -14%. The largest net losses at the individual carload level were Coal, Other, and Mining with each commodity group experiencing over 4,000 carloads lost compared to August 2024.

Definitions

- **Originated**- A carload’s initial point of shipment.
- **Bridged** - A carload shipment that originates on one railroad, is transported by a bridge railroad, and then transferred to another railroad for its final destination.
- **Terminated** - A carload shipment of a commodity that originated on one railroad but was unloaded from the receiving railroad at its final destination, with no further rail transportation planned.
- **Total handled** – Total number of individual carloads that were either an origination, termination, or a bridge movement, moved by at least one short line. This total will generally be smaller than the sum of originated, bridged and terminated movements as adding those together results in double (or triple) counting of the same carload.

Carload data is based on a custom short line carload report created in cooperation between ASLRRRA and Railinc based on Waybill data submitted by railroads.
