



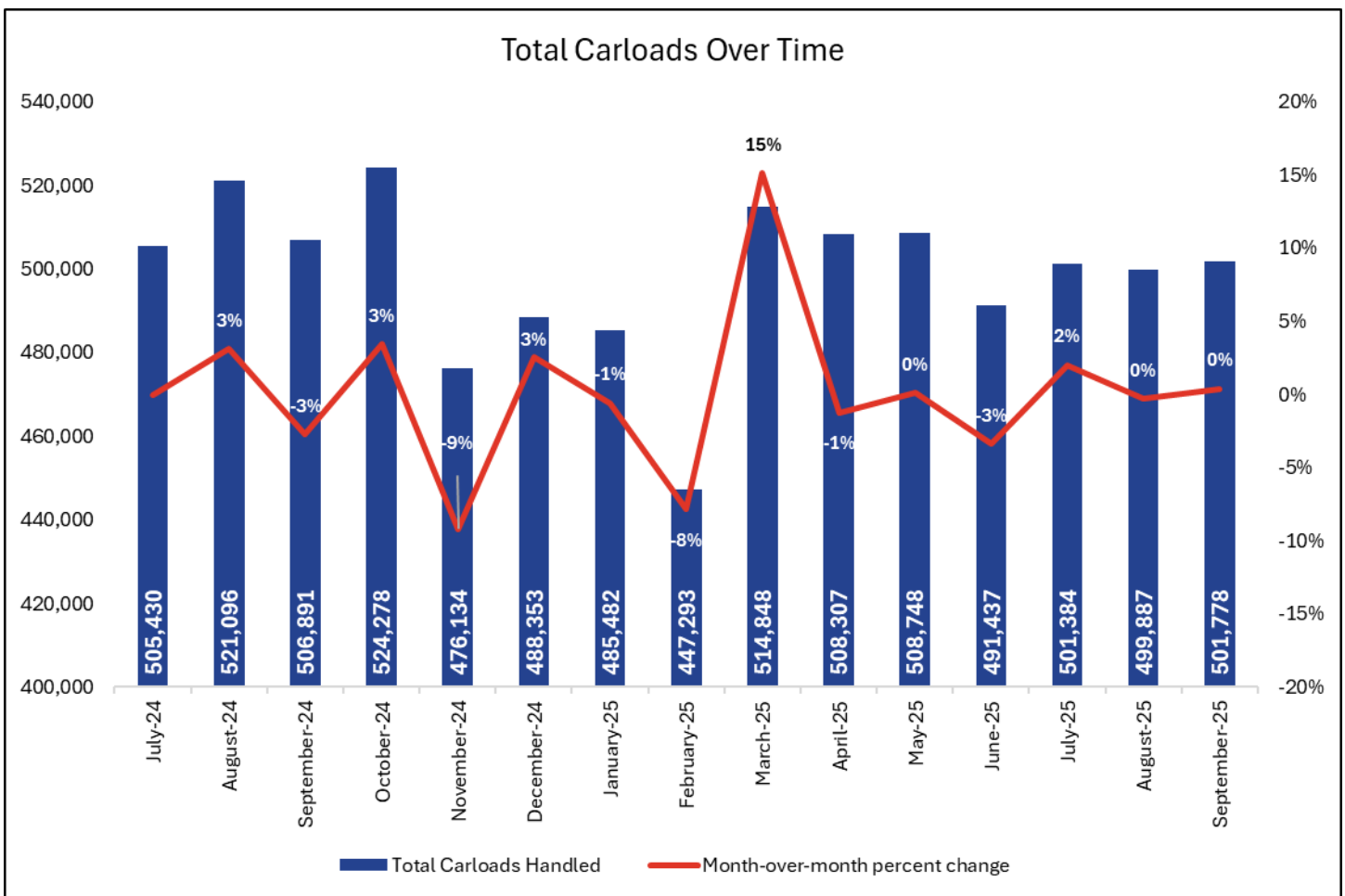
Short Line Carloads Report – November 2025

ASLRRRA Second Carloads Report

ASLRRRA is proud to share the second in its new ongoing series of reports presenting short line carload volumes and recent trends and changes.

Overall Short Line Carloads Volumes

This table presents the long-term trends of carloads handled by short lines and the respective month-over-month percent change. This data series begins with July 2024 carloads, hence there is no data for a month to month change in that field. As seen below, July, August, and September have remained remarkably consistent with total carloads handled floating around 500,000 a month.

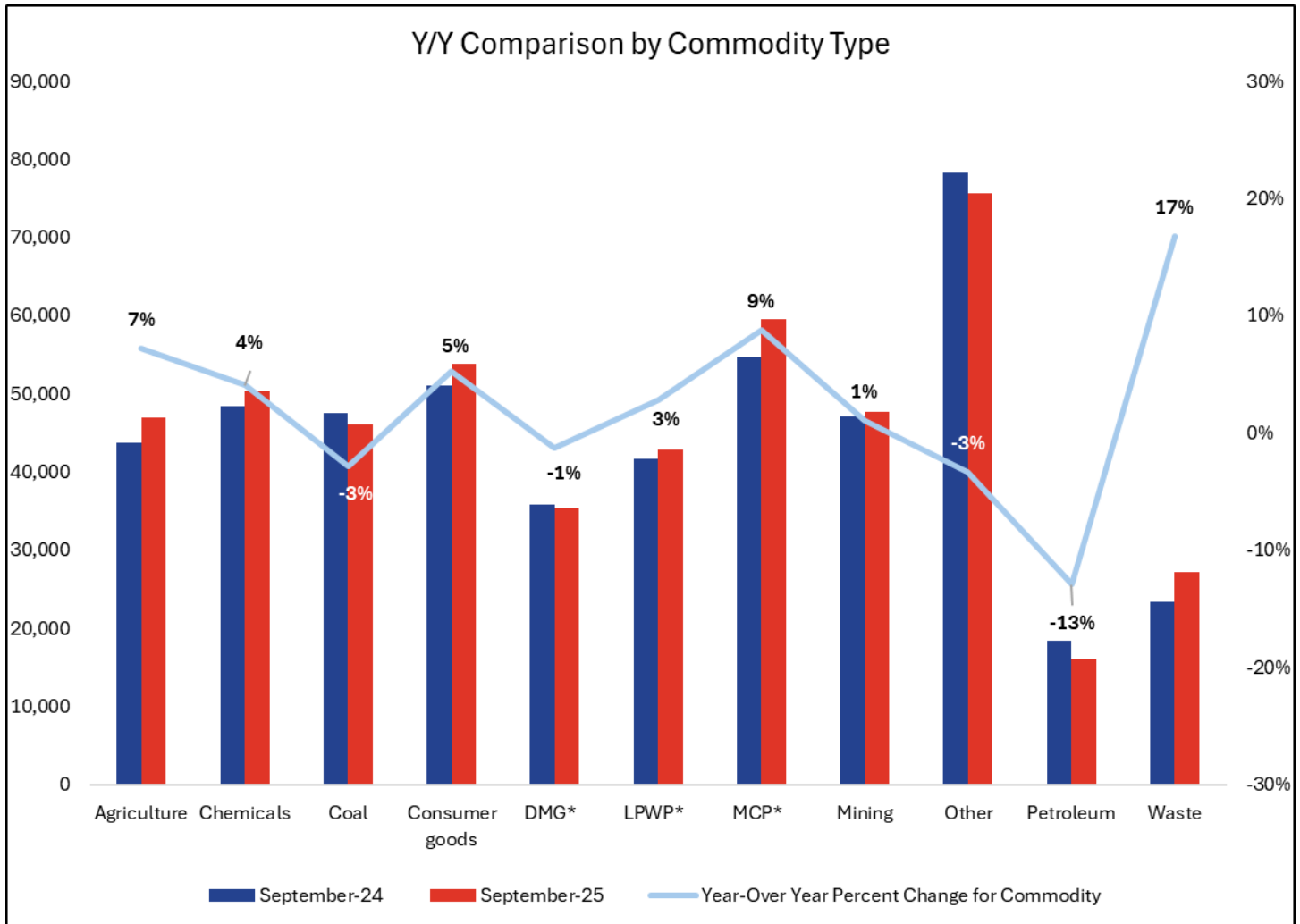


Short Line Carload Trends

Comparing overall carloads handled, as well as by movement-type, shows the overall volumes remaining consistent with only a 2% increase compared to September 2024. The most notable change was the decrease in bridge movements with the category dropping by a fifth. Modest gains in originating and terminating carloads helped offset those losses.

DMG – Durable Manufactured Goods

For September, short line carloads movements saw the greatest growth in Waste (17%), Manufacturing or construction products (9%), and Agriculture (7%) compared to September 2024. The largest decreases were seen in carloads for petroleum products (-13%). When looking at raw carload volumes Manufacturing or construction products also saw the greatest growth with a net gain of 4,790 carloads compared to Petroleum products decreasing by a net negative 2,567 carloads.

Definitions

- **Originated**- A carload’s initial point of shipment.
- **Bridged** - A carload shipment that originates on one railroad, is transported by a bridge railroad, and then transferred to another railroad for its final destination.
- **Terminated** - A carload shipment of a commodity that originated on one railroad but was unloaded from the receiving railroad at its final destination, with no further rail transportation planned.
- **Total handled** – Total number of individual carloads that were either an origination, termination, or a bridge movement, moved by at least one short line. This total will generally be smaller than the sum of originated, bridged and terminated movements as adding those together results in double (or triple) counting of the same carload.

Carload data is based on a custom short line carload report created in cooperation between ASLRRRA and Railinc based on waybill data submitted by railroads.
